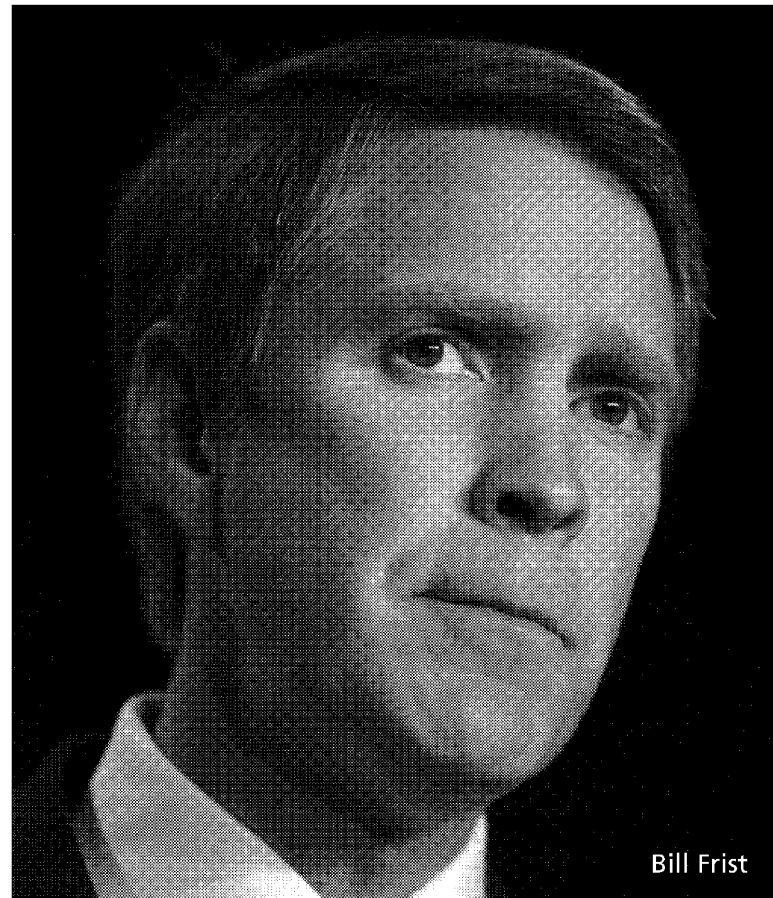


# More interested in checks

Countless scandals swirl around Tom DeLay. He has been caught accepting overseas trips paid for by corporate lobbyists and offshore companies, misusing money from his children's charity and paying his family more than \$500,000 from campaign funds. He is even accused of illegally raising and spending money in exchange for political favors. So now, Tom DeLay is pandering to the radical right and big corporate donors to try and cover it up. They promise to defend him blindly and to fill his campaign coffers, despite all the mounting evidence. What does he promise in return?

## Bill Frist. Pandering for a new job.

In his quest for power, Bill Frist is leading the effort to undo 200 years of checks and balances in the Senate, destroying the independence of America's judiciary. That's because Bill Frist wants to be our next President. So Frist is pandering to big corporations and the radical right who will bankroll his campaign and mobilize millions of right-wing voters. Frist wants to be president so bad he is willing to sacrifice the rights and interests of ordinary Americans to meet the needs and wishes of the extremist wing of the Republican Party.

In November 2004, no one knew that a vote for the Republican Party was a vote for absolute power, or a party that would work to end the system of checks and balances that has kept our judiciary fair and our democracy strong. No one knew they would be voting for a party that was more interested in money and power than the good of the nation.
